Fishing & Hunting:

Fort Leonard Wood Hunting Blind (former Towersite):

Completely enclosed accessible hunting blinds. First come, first serve. St. Robert.

Laughlin/Roubidoux Park & River Task: Disabled access parking and fishing area. Waynesville 573.774.6171

Riddle Bridge Access: Fishing and boat launch access. Accessible restroom. St. Robert

Schlicht Springs River Access: Fishing and public access. Accessible restroom and parking. Crocker

Stone Mill Spring: Trout fishing. Two accessible fishing docks. Contact DPW Natural Resources for key to gate for closer parking. 573.596.2814. FLW

Frisco Park - Frisco Railroad Caboose & Crocker Veterans Memorial: An original caboose that makes a great photo op. Veterans memorial honoring those who served. Gravel parking lot, level concrete sidewalk. Crocker

Memorial Grove Park: Stones, monuments and plaques honoring those in the Chemical and Military Police Corps and the Engineers. Concrete walking trail. Accessible parking. Fort Leonard Wood

Trail of Tears Memorial: Interpretive memorial and concrete walking trail honoring the sacrifice of the Cherokee. Partnered with the National Park Service.

Attractions and Recreation:

Bow & Barrel Sportsmen Center: Indoor shooting range, outdoor archery range. 2 accessible shooting stations, accessible parking St. Robert 573.451.2129

Frisco Depot Museum:

Exhibits and artifacts on the Frisco Railroad and the local frontier. Open on the third Saturday for hours April - Oct. Wheelchair ramp with lip at top of ramp and at entryway. Lonnie Garrett 573.528.3550



Mahaffey Museum Complex: This complex houses the Military Police, U.S. Army Engineer, and Chemical Corps Museums along with several gift shops. Accessible parking and displays. Historic Vehicle Park and WWII Mobilization Area are accessible from the Museum Complex and by their own accessible parking. Fort Leonard Wood



Pulaski County Courthouse Museum: A 1903 Courtroom featuring a warm room, a piece of the world trade center and many other displays. Open Saturdays April - Sept. First floor accessible, stairs to 2nd floor. Waynesville 573.855.3644

Mural: 8 foot shield, an interactive mural, and Waynesville mural are great photo ops locations! Located on the square in Waynesville and one block west. Handicapped parking spaces, concrete sidewalk.
